Fast Track/Bridge Program

Fast Track offers up to six (6) units free of charge per semester to concurrently enrolled HS students. The Bridge Program brings College of the Sequoias courses to HS campuses.

STEPS

Complete a COS Web Application*

(Continuing concurrently enrolled high school students do not need to reapply.)

Access the COS application by visiting the COS website at www.cos.edu and clicking on the link **Enroll Now**. Submit the application online and print a copy of the confirmation page for your records.

Complete the Concurrent High School Permission form each semester.

You may print the form from the COS website, obtain it from your high school counselor, the COS Admissions & Records Office in (Room 107), or the COS Hanford Center. To obtain the form from the website www.cos.edu, click the link **Classes**. Then Click the link **High School Programs**. You will see the link for the permission form. Turn this form into the COS Admissions & Records Office or the COS Hanford Center.
