

ELECTION OF STUDENT MEMBER

The student member of the governing board shall be elected as follows:

1. The election shall be by ballot under the supervision of the Elections Committee of the Student Senate.
2. The election shall be held in the Spring semester no later than the third week of May for the purpose of electing the officers for the following term of office.
3. Any enrolled student at the College of the Sequoias is eligible to vote.
4. Nominations of candidates shall be by petition filed with the Student Senate Advisor by the deadline date established by the Elections Committee.
5. The petition shall be signed by the candidate certifying they:
 - a. Are a resident of California at the time of the nomination and will remain a California resident during the term of their service;
 - b. Are enrolled in and will maintain a minimum of twelve (12) semester units in the District at the time of nomination and throughout the term of their service;
 - c. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 at the time of election and will maintain this grade point average throughout their term in office;
 - d. Have a current Student ID card.
6. If any elected position is not filled in a general election, or if it is left vacated by resignation or dismissal of the office holder, then it will be deemed an appointed position and shall be filled by the Student Senate Membership Committee within two (2) weeks.
