## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Admission to the BSN program is competitive, but not impossible. We use a holistic admission process with a focus on student essays. Applicants are considered for admission based upon the following criteria:

- Completion of at least 60 semester units of transferable coursework, including all prerequisites, by the time of entry into the program
- Recommended prerequisite and science GPA above 3.0
- Scores on the HESI Admission Assessment or TEAS
- Letters of Recommendation
- Short answer responses submitted with your application


