RN to BSN

The online Bachelor of Science in Nursing is for registered nurses whose schedules make it difficult to complete a traditional campus-based program.

Most BSN courses are offered online giving students the flexibility of accessing courses conveniently.

With both full-time & part-time options, our students can obtain their BSN degree in as few as two semesters!

Admissions Requirements

- 60 or more transferable college units* (70 semester units/105 quarter units maximum accepted from community colleges and 90 units from a four-year institution)
- Active unencumbered CA RN license **or** transcripts showing you will complete your Regionally Accredited RN program before starting the RN-BSN program.
- College GPA of at least 2.0⁺

**Applicants with a Bachelor's degree in another major are considered 2nd baccalaureate students. GPA (from the 1st bachelor's degree) of at least 2.5 or higher is required.*

- Completion of the following Pre-requisite courses:
 - ♦ **English Composition** (3 units)
 - ♦ **Critical Thinking/Logic** (3 units)
 - ♦ **Oral Communication** (3 units)
 - ♦ **Statistics-inferential and descriptive** (3 units)
 - ♦ **College Chemistry** (*College chemistry includes general, inorganic, organic, or integrated chemistry*)
 - ♦ **Human Anatomy** (with required lab)
 - ♦ **Human Physiology** (with required lab)
 - ♦ **Microbiology** (with required lab)

**We recommend obtaining G.E. certification from a community college prior to admission.*

What equipment do I need?
