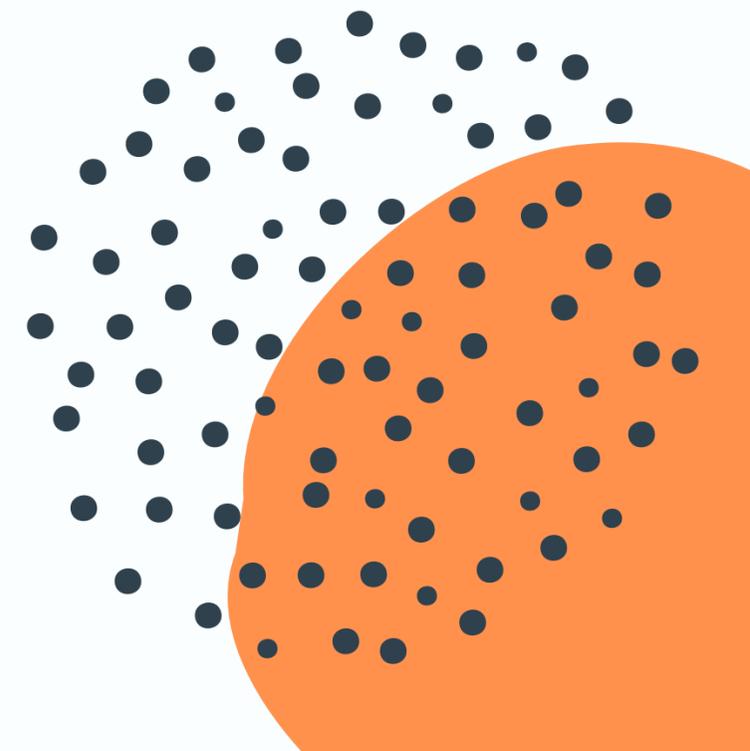


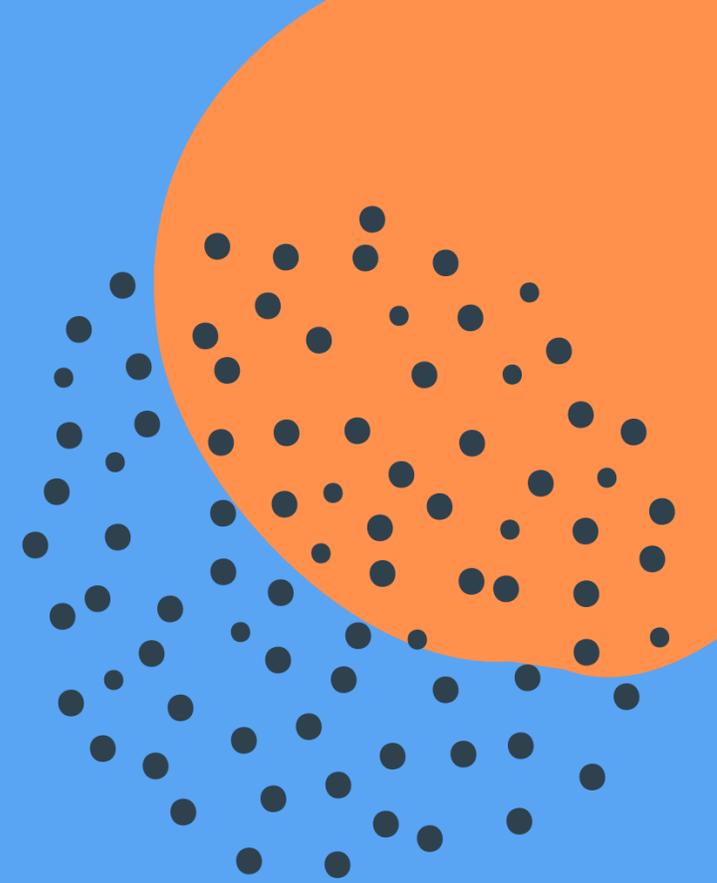

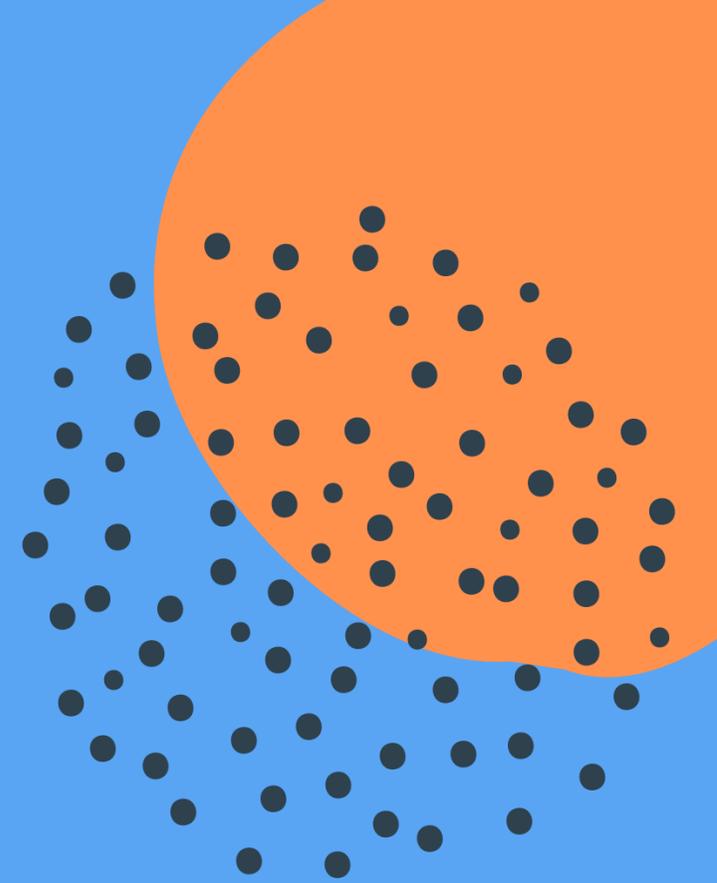
An Instructor's Perspective to Canvas Rubrics



EXPECTATIONS

- Level of mastery is outlined
- Criteria is set and conveyed to student prior to completing assignment
- Allows student to self-assess to achieve desired grade (Ownership)
- Fewer questions on specific parameters and more focus on content
- Good instructor "check." Is this assignment aligned to SLOs? Is it measuring intended goals?

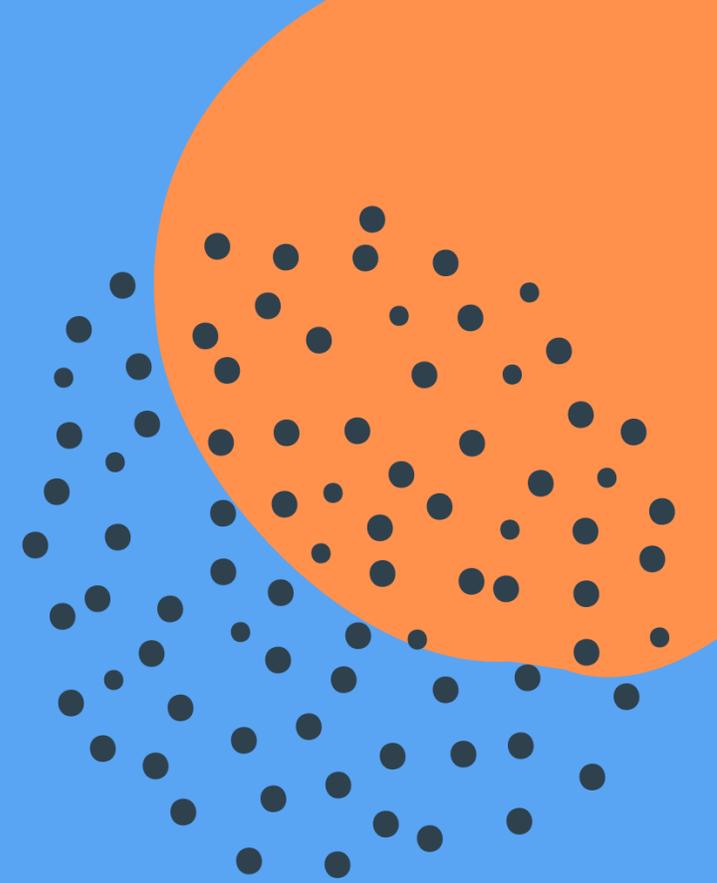
An Instructor's Perspective to Canvas Rubrics



ACCESS

- Located in Canvas
- Directly attached to assignment, discussion, quiz, etc.
- Stored in Canvas over the semester and can be reviewed

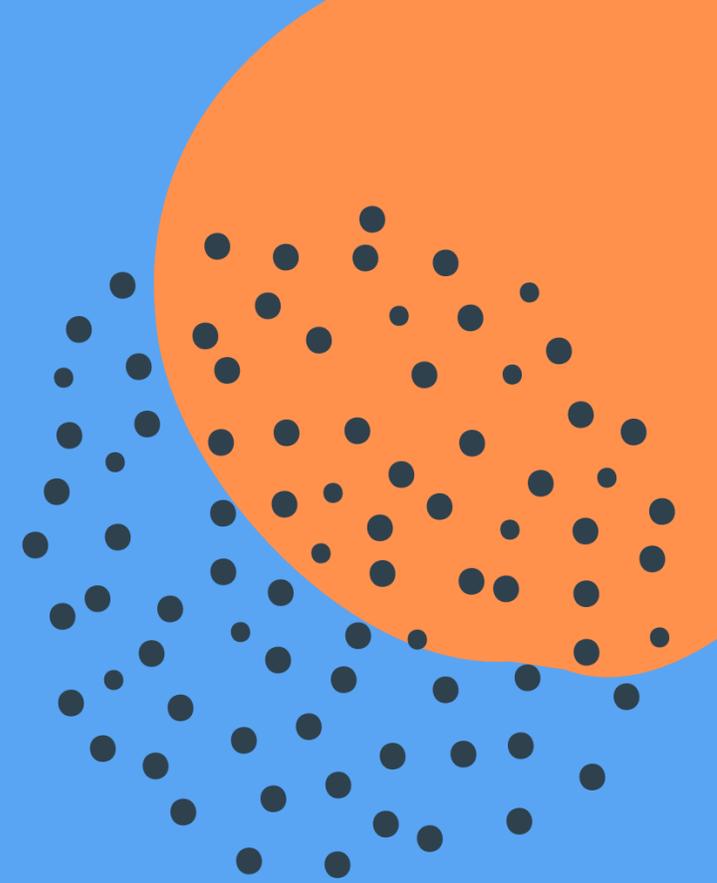
An Instructor's Perspective to Canvas Rubrics



FLEXIBILITY & EASE

- Ratings can be set as absolutes or within a range
- Criteria and ratings can be simple or complex
- Points can be included, hidden, or not applied
- Extra credit/points option
- Narrative comments can be minimized, but also included for each criteria
- Rubrics can be used from other assignments, discussions, classes, etc. (Find a Rubric icon)
- Grading is streamlined-SpeedGrader/Rubric

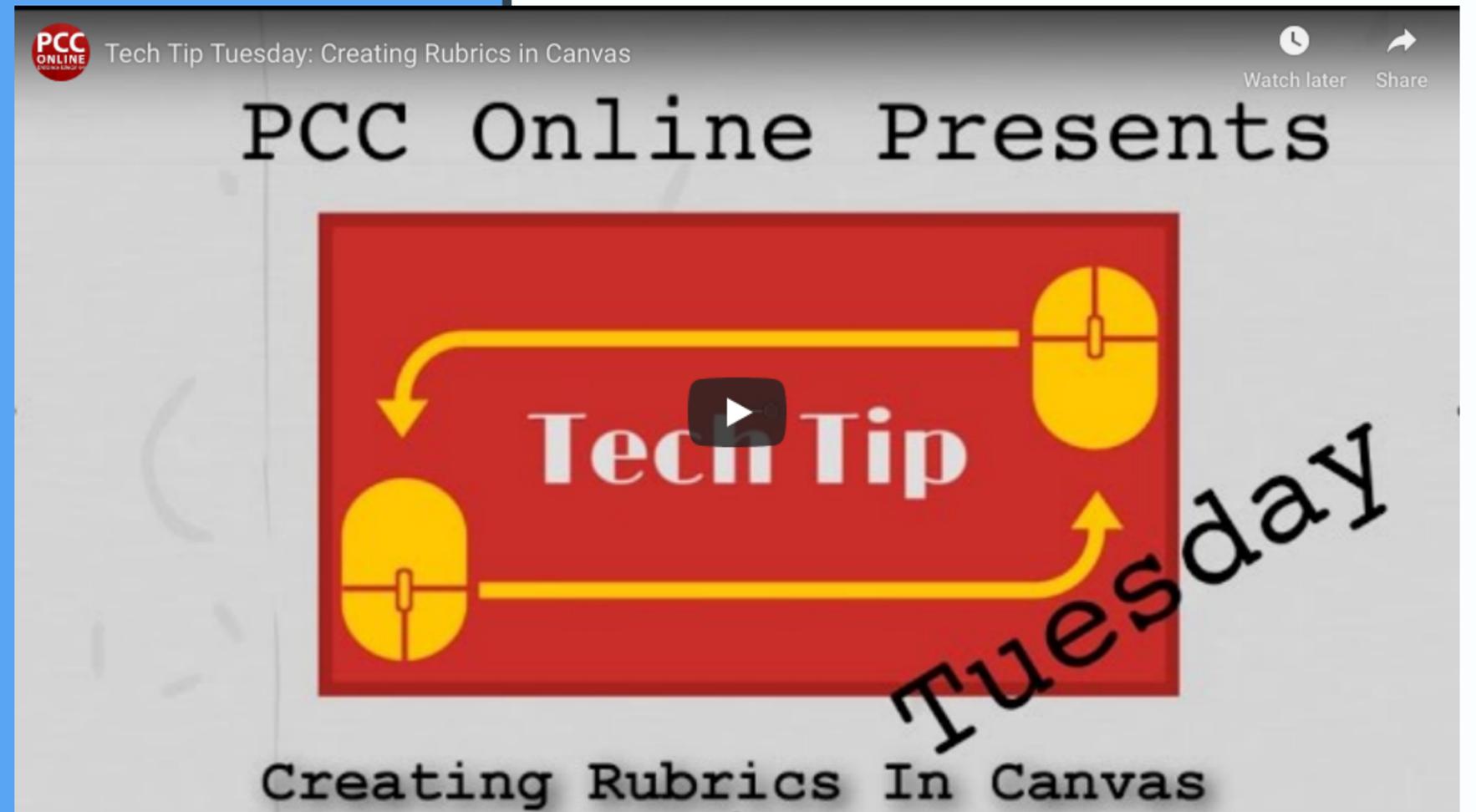
An Instructor's Perspective to Canvas Rubrics



TIPS & INSIGHTS FROM A NOVICE

- Create/add the assignment, quiz, discussion, outcome in Canvas first
- Start with a rubric from Word built on your SLOs/Objective so you just have to copy and past verbiage and you know the structure needed for the Canvas rubric
- Don't leave the rubric until you have selected "Create Rubric" or "Update Rubric"
- Don't make changes to the rubric once students submit assignment, quiz, discussion
- Mute your assignment once you plan to start grading and grade within Speedgrader

"It's easier because you always have it."

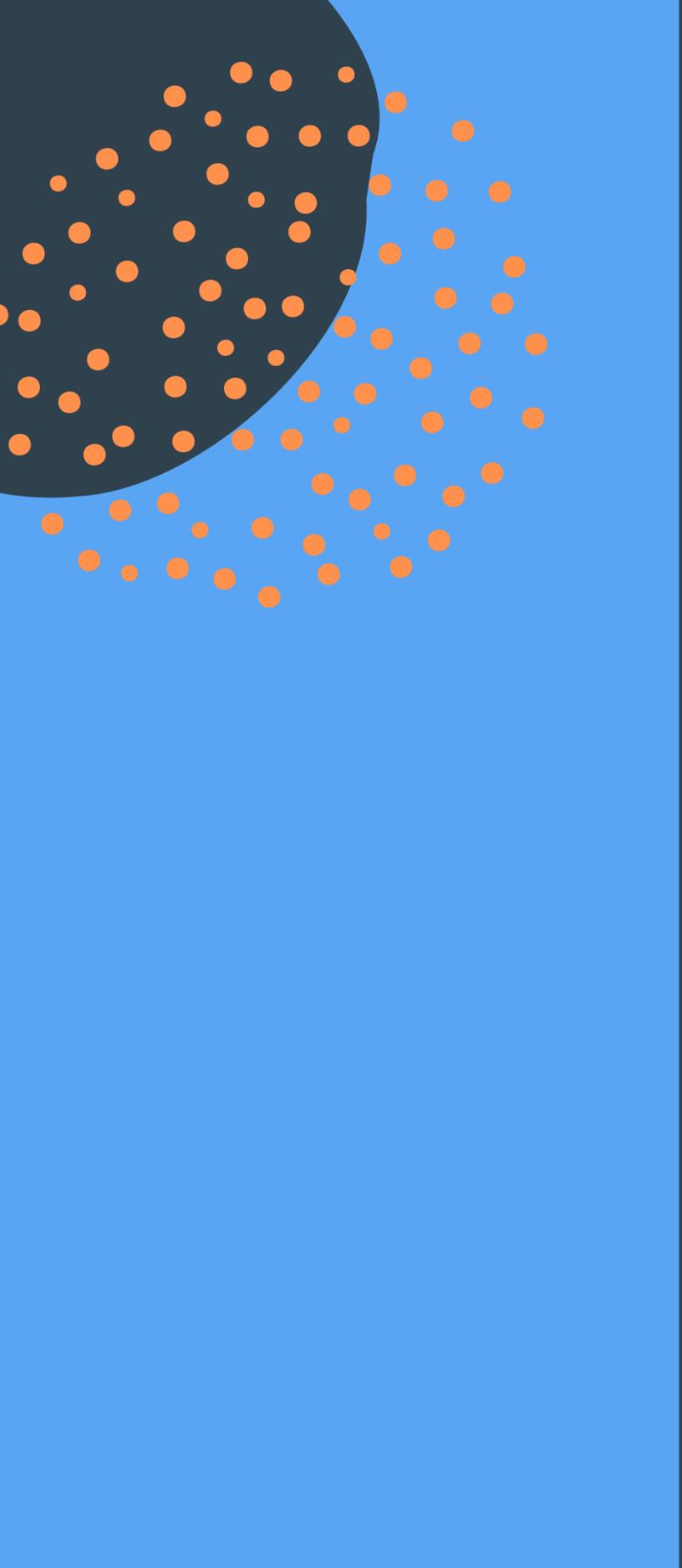
