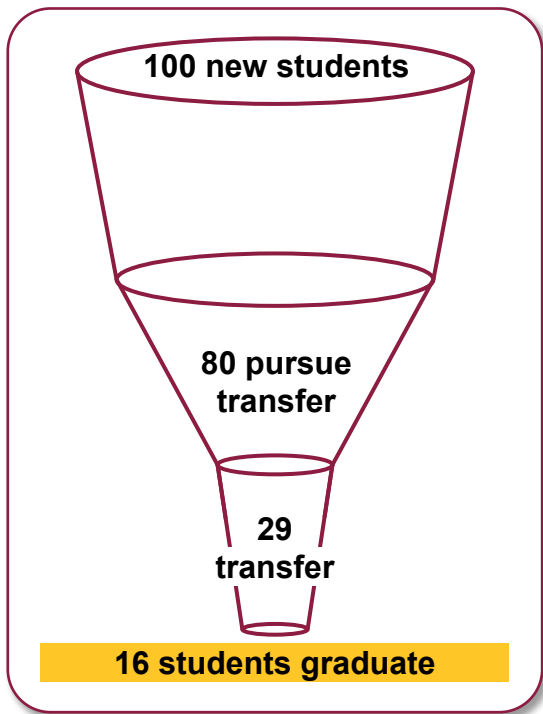

Developing Solutions at Scale

Framing the National Transfer Problem

Only one-in-six starting community college earn a bachelor's degree within 6 years



Primary best practice: promote clearly mapped paths to transfer into major of interest.



Students who complete their associate degree prior to transfer are **6-7x** more likely to get their bachelor's degree



Students who can transfer 90% of their credits are **2.5x** more likely to get their bachelor's degree, compared to those who can transfer fewer credits

Students join ASU Local, enabling them to access over 130+ online majors without leaving the local community.

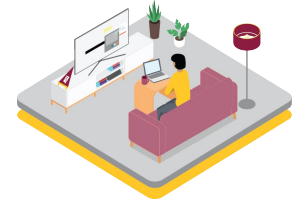

Please note: Raise Me is only available to domestic and international students attending ASU in person.

Students demonstrating financial need can earn up to a maximum of \$2,000 in micro scholarships once admitted and enrolled to ASU, in addition to other earned scholarships:

- \$100 for signing up for a MyPath2ASU™
- \$250 for visiting an ASU campus
- \$100 for sending a FAFSA to ASU
- \$10/credit (up to 60 credit hours) for each 0.1 points above a 3.5 GPA (up to \$900 maximum)
- \$75 for each “A” in any course (up to \$1,050 maximum)
- \$75 for each non-sport extracurricular activity per school year (At least one-year participation, up to \$300)
- \$3 for every hour of community service (20 hours minimum), up to \$150 maximum
- \$100 for 200 or more hours of work experience across all jobs, internships and to help support your family
- \$400 for receiving the honor, Phi Theta Kappa Member, from Phi Theta Kappa (up to \$500 maximum)
- \$200 for indicating that you plan to complete your associate degree

Credit for Military Experience

Credits are evaluated at time of JST submission to ASU. It is recommended the JST be sent to ASU upon application to ensure timely processing and evaluation.

The evaluation decision is made based on the content of the experience and information is shared through the Transfer Guide for all current and prospective students. Students can earn no more than 60 credit hours in independent learning courses, which includes military experience and credit by exam.

Credit for Military Experience

In compliance with Arizona statute SB 1267, Veterans or active duty students are awarded Military Science Department elective credit (MIS DEC) based on time in service. This is in addition to any credit awarded from the Joint Service Transcript according to the process described on the previous slide.

Military credits that transfer to ASU through educational experiences in the armed services are not applicable toward completing ASU's general studies requirements for graduation but do count for total credits toward completion. Students can earn up to 60 credit hours in independent learning courses, which includes military experience.

75 Credit Hour Options

Students can transfer **up to 75 credit hours** of community college coursework upon successful completion of an Associate Degree from partnering community colleges:

- Interdisciplinary Studies, BA
- Liberal Studies, BA
- Organizational Leadership, BA

Students admitted to the BSN program online can pursue **RN to BSN** or **Concurrent Enrollment Program**. Up to 75 transfer credits from a regionally accredited associate degree nursing program may be accepted and applied to the online BSN program.


